



## Terms & Conditions summary

**PLUSBUS** tickets offer unlimited\* local bus travel on participating bus operators services, on the date specified on the ticket, anywhere within the defined urban travel zone that relates to the origin or destination on the ticket shown as:

**'STATION NAME+BUS'**.

\*In certain areas some 'special services' (such as airport express routes, night services and inter-urban express coaches) may not accept **PLUSBUS** tickets for travel. These are known as "excluded services".

It is the passengers' responsibility to ensure that there is a suitable bus service available, on the day and at the time that they wish to travel by bus. Passengers are advised to check bus routes and timetables with participating bus operators, or:

Passengers must be in possession of their **PLUSBUS** ticket before starting their journey. If **PLUSBUS** is required to get to the station at the start of the journey, then tickets **MUST** be obtained by post, by courier or arrangements must be made to collect them prior to the start of the journey.
